- **Tech Team Members** – operating our in-church visuals projection, sound system and video live-stream on a rota basis. Full training given.

The larger the team of volunteers we have, the easier the workload on each individual, so please do give serious thought to how you can serve the church. Some roles will need the necessary safeguarding training to be undertaken and DBS checks to be made. Finally, a sincere 'thank you' to all existing volunteers who help our church operate!
