To Whom shall we go

John 6: 56-69

How does it feel when life suddenly changes? The people of Afghanistan have experienced sudden and scary change this week as the Taliban, an extreme military group, has taken control of the country. News reports show people in shock and fearful for the future. Young people there are unsure whether they will even be able to return to school.

Moments of fear and uncertainty can be overwhelming and leave us with fundamental questions and choices. In this week's passage, the disciples struggle to understand Jesus' teaching. Some find it so difficult that they choose to leave. Jesus asks the 12 if they also wish to leave, but they respond with the question, 'to whom can we go?'

Choosing to follow Jesus is not an easy choice, and it is not simply a case of making this decision once. As life throws difficult circumstances our way, we are constantly challenged to wrestle with difficult questions and choose again to follow Jesus. The disciples learn that they can ask their questions, show their fears, and look to Jesus in times of uncertainty.

Where do you turn at times of change? Who do you talk to about your own questions and fears? How can you support others in the group when they face difficult changes? Whether you have questions about your own situations or those concerning worldwide issues, bring them to Jesus in prayer. Like Simon Peter, choose again to follow Jesus, trusting Him and listening to His words of spirit and life.
