MD 10K—Support NEEDED: The postponed Market Drayton 10K race will take place on <u>Sunday 3rd October</u> and once again, we would like to encourage you all to take part in some way in this community event.

- For those of you not keen on actually running the race, there are lots of supporting roles needed. Firstly, marshalls are once again needed along the route. If you can volunteer to marshall, please go down to the Grove school field between 2-5pm on Saturday 2nd October to book your marshalling point and collect your equipment.
- Help is also needed at the Grove Field (start/finish point) during the dayplease be there at 8am if you can help the organisational team.
- We also want to be a Christian presence at the Grove, with either the Big Blue Bus or some gazebos. Please consider coming down and helping provide refreshments, crafts or just chatting to those passing by.

SUNDAY 3RD OCTOBER MORNING SERVICE will be at the adjusted time of

10am. This is to allow plenty of time between the short service ending and the 10K race commencing at 11am.
