- \* If you would like prayer after the service, please take a seat on the front row and a member of the prayer team will come to you.





### **MARKET DRAYTON FOODBANK HARVEST APPEAL:**

Since the pandemic and the cost of living crisis began, food banks in the Trussell Trust network have seen a huge surge in need as more and more people find themselves unable to afford the essentials. This simply isn't right, and this Harvest we want to make a difference by working together as a community to transform lives here in Market Drayton.

Foodbank supports individuals and families in crisis by providing emergency food supplies, as well as signposting people to agencies that are able to help resolve longer-term problems. Food banks rely on voluntary donations to provide this vital service to our community, and lots of these food donations come from Harvest collections. We want to make sure our Foodbank can support as many people as possible at this time – and you can help by joining our Harvest Appeal.

What to collect—Please collect non-perishable food items (tinned and dried goods), which do not spoil or decay. This means that neither the food bank nor the recipient has to worry about storing food in a fridge or freezer, and there is less likelihood of food going to waste. It also means that we can give each person who comes to our food bank a carefully designed food parcel that contains three days' worth of nutritionally-balanced food. All items should be unopened, in date and in good condition. We also take non-food items such as laundry powder, washing up liquid and cleaning products, as these are just as essential for the people who use food banks. **Delivery/collection**—It would be a great help if you could deliver your collection to the foodbank at the Parish Rooms on Tuesdays or Fridays 9-10.30am only, or at Supermarkets. If you are struggling to drop off your donations, please email us at <a href="mailto:info@marketdrayton.foodbank.org.uk">info@marketdrayton.foodbank.org.uk</a> and we'll do our best to arrange a date and time with you to collect your donation safely.
