Jeff and Julia have been friends of us here at MDMC for many years, and they will also join us for a bring and share tea at 4:30pm, an opportunity to share fellowship with them before they move to Torquay this summer for Jeff's next ministerial appointment. Do come and join us for some fantastic worship and no doubt a powerful and challenging message from God through Jeff.

**COFFEE MORNING:** MWiB will be holding a coffee morning next Saturday 16th July from 10am till 12noon in aid of Mission in Britain. **LOVING: HURTING: DREAMING—ARTWORK DISPLAY:** This piece of artwork is a triptych of 3 panels; each at least 2m high and wide, painted by the Christian artist, Jake Lever, in 2019 and designed to be used by adults and school groups as an aid to reflection and prayer. It will be on display at St Peter's Church, Stoke on Tern who are borrowing it to use with the Year 6 school leavers in the United Benefice on a Retreat Day. **EXTREME TOUR 2022:** Ed Jervis (Jeannette and Derek's son-in-law) helps to co-ordinate the British leg of "The Extreme Tour" which matches American Christian musicians with British Christian musicians and takes them on tour. They visited Market Drayton three years ago and it was a great success. The aim is to return this year on the weekend of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> September, to do a gig to/with the young people at the skate park on the Saturday and a larger, family event concert at The Zone on the Sunday. This is a great opportunity for them and us to meet and mix with people and share God with them! There are lots of things you can be doing to help:

- **Pray**, for smooth organization, safe journeys, good weather, that the team can come to Market Drayton and that God will be shared with those who attend.
- **Food**. We have been asked to provide three meals for the team of fifteen people over the weekend. Last time house groups took responsibility for one meal each and then split the meal into main dishes, desserts and drinks and were able to provide for the team in that way. Please consider whether you or your housegroup might be able to help in this way.
- **Finance**. The cost is approx at £1000 per venue. We have submitted an

application to the town council for a grant, but we as a church are likely to need to meet the vast majority of the financial cost. If you feel that you could contribute towards the cost of this amazing, missional outreach event please see Mark Lawrence or Kev Lee or Gail Ackerley.
