FOODBANK BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

Do you have a financial background? Do you have a concern for those in need? Would you be interested in working with an established and well-respected local charity? If so, read on...

Started in 2012 by the churches of the town, Market Drayton Foodbank is committed to helping those facing food poverty, whilst also seeking to help our clients address some of its underlying causes.

The Foodbank is part of the Trussell Trust network, but became its own Charitable Incorporated Organisation in May 2022 and much of the work involved in getting the new charity established has been completed.

The Board of Trustees are now looking for someone with accounting experience to join the Board in a voluntary capacity, who will be able to advise on financial matters, ensure we meet our financial obligations and help us build a sound financial strategy as we move forward. The Board of Trustees meet 4-6 times a year (for 1 to 2 hours each time), with interim responsibility and actions as required. The time commitment between meetings is estimated to be up to around 4 hours a month, depending on the time of the financial year.
